How do you define success?

Even if I never get to reach a 7 minute mile in one year, I will have improved myself by trying and that in my opinion is success. It is setting goals and improving yourself to achieve them.

Most influential person and why?

I know it sounds cliché but Jesus Christ is the most influential person in my life and here is why. Jesus is the son of God. He has all the power in the universe and yet he came to earth like a regular man. He always kept his cool, knowing that at any moment he could just say the words and the world would be toast.
